## **RULES & CONDITIONS**

1. Unaccompanied Competitors must provide the Show Organiser a contact telephone number in case of an emergency in accordance with Rule 31.5.
2. Prizes may be limited in accordance with Rule 76.6.
3. No British Showjumping member will allow a stallion of which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury in accordance with Rule 82.21. Also refer to Rule 102.12.
4. All classes will be judged under British Showjumping Rules.
5. The Judges and Organisers decision is final.
6. Prizes may be limited in accordance with Rule No. 76.6.
7. The Show organisers have the right to cancel any class with less than 3 entries.
8. Once the class has been entered, no refund will be given without a significant explanation as to why the competitor wishes to withdraw from the class.

The organisers have taken responsible precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone attending. For these measures to be effective, everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any Official must be adhered to. Any animal not under control or in anyway constituting a danger, may be asked to leave the showground. Owners enter their horse at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Show organisers.

### **FIRST AID CHARGES – NEW RULES EFFECTIVE FROM 1ST OCTOBER 2011**

From 1st October 2011, new rules regarding medical cover at Affiliated Shows will come into effect.

From 1st October 2011 shows will only be permitted to charge British Showjumping members for medical cover at affiliated Shows, if qualified external medical providers with appropriate insurance cover are used.
